- Allow individual interpretations of a story




### Story Arc/ Narrative Arc

# Ostrobothnian oldest beacon/lighthouse


- Mojkepä beacon 1668-1808,
- Replica of firepit build in 2001 after drawing from 1620s
- Today: Molpehällorna, former pilot station





A story about the lighthouse keeper Jakob Rautio, his youth love Katri, his arch enemy Russian soldier Nikita Tolstoi, the Russian capten Alexander Strogoi and the girl Selmi.
